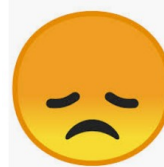

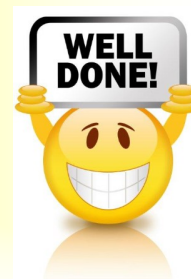
## ATTENDANCE.
