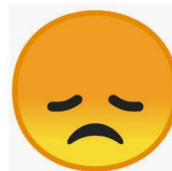

### GOOD TO BE GREEN:

Just to refresh minds about our Good to be Green system. This was introduced last January to provide a consistent approach to behaviour throughout the school. Children have responded very well to this and feel that it is a fair and consistent way of dealing with the rare occurrences of poor behaviour choices. When a child has received a red card a member of the Senior Leadership Team spends time with the child talking about the choices they made and reflecting on what they could have done differently and who they can talk to. It is a restorative approach and one that has been recognised as consistent throughout the school so that the children know that everything is dealt with in a fair and well thought out way. It also recognises those children (of whom it is the majority) who constantly make the right choices throughout the day.
